

### PRESCHOOL INFORMATION

The first day of preschool will be Monday, August 19th. Morning preschool is from 8:00 am - 11:15 am and afternoon preschool is from 11:50 am - 3:05 pm. In addition to preschool on Monday through Thursday, there will be preschool on the following days as well. Morning preschool will meet on October 23rd, November 27th, and February 19th, from 8:00 am - 11:15 am and afternoon preschool will meet on October 24th, December 20th, and February 20th from 8:00 am - 11:15 am, and no school on November 25th for the afternoon session.

Before the school year begins, please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and current immunization records. The first tuition payment is due on or before August 1, 2024. Payment for each subsequent month will be due on or before the 20th of the month. There will be a grace period of five days if payment is not received by the 20th. Payments can be mailed to the elementary school (PO Box 430 Fort Calhoun, NE 68023), brought to the elementary office during school hours, or by setting up automatic payments through eFunds. Tuition is \$150 per month.
